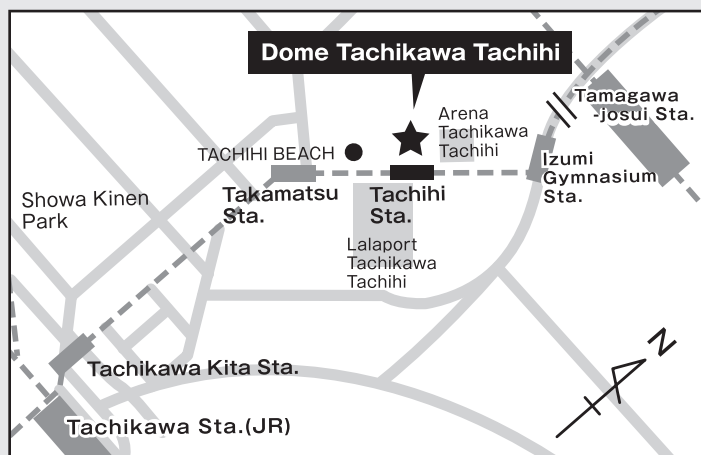

He competed in three consecutive Olympic Games. He won the gold medal in the Men's Team at the 2004 Athens Olympics.
